Monthly Networking Meetings: These social and business oriented "Meetups" are an opportunity for people to learn about the Committee's activities and to meet others who have an interest in Vietnam. Attendees include businesspeople, researchers, tourists, educators, students, veterans, leaders of other NGOs and governmental agencies.

Economic and Goodwill Missions: The Committee organizes in-bound and out-bound visits from and to Vietnam. Delegates learn about the economic, political and social changes that are taking place throughout the countries and are introduced to new business opportunities.

Healthcare and Biotechnology Programs: The Committee is exploring ways that the health system of Vietnam can be improved with a special interest in HIV/AIDS, Hepatitis B and C, Agent Orange and head trauma. The Committee organizes forums to facilitate these discussions between delegates from San Francisco and Ho Chi Minh City.

Art and Cultural Programs: The art and culture of Vietnam is of tremendous interest to the Committee. Join us and learn to speak, read and write Vietnamese, learn about Vietnamese folklore, the country's history, and its people. The Committee facilitates a book exchange program in cooperation with the San Francisco Public Library and promotes sports exchanges.

Transportation/Urban Planning Programs: Ho Chi Minh City is a large, vibrant city. The SFHCMC Sister City Committee proudly continues providing the expertise of urban planners, architects and engineers in the development of the infrastructure of Ho Chi Minh City. The Committee is also collaborating with the Smithsonian Institution and The California Academy of Sciences to plan, design and construct a state of the art natural history museum in Ho Chi Minh City. The Committee also enthusiastically supports direct flights between the Sister Cities.

Other Programs: The Committee organizes special events that recognize and celebrate the Sister City relationship and/or individuals that are key to its success. *All people of goodwill are invited to join us in our efforts.*

This handsome California Spanish Revival hotel offers an inviting club atmosphere that is rich with history, honor and pride. Owned and operated by the Marines' Memorial Association, a 501(c) 19 Veterans Non-Profit Organization, Marines' Memorial Club is the first ever "Living Memorial" in the United States, offering historic exhibits featuring American military history from all eras, and a library and museum with artifacts and books donated by grateful members, Veterans and their families.

The club offers first class guestrooms, elegant and spacious suites, a rooftop restaurant and bar, the 564-seat Marines' Memorial Theatre, and exquisite ballrooms. All club members and guests are welcome!
